Digitization and Industry 4.0

Ulrich Hilpert | F. Schiller University

Ulrich Hilpert, Ph.D., Professor and Chair of Comparative Government at the Friedrich Schiller University, Jena, Germany. Ulrich Hilpert's major research fields include techno-industrial innovation, related government policies, restructuring, environmental technologies, globalization, and regional analysis. He has directed several international research networks on the regionalization of innovation, sub-national collaboration for regional development, and on diversities of innovation. Dr. Hilpert was consultant to the Commission of the European Communities (Brussels), to the Organization of Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), and to ministries in several German Länder, as well as to national and international labour unions and business organizations on innovation, workforce, and regional development. For six years, he has been running a working group on regional innovation and restructuring in East Germany. He has held positions at the Universities of Constance, Free University of Berlin and was visiting Professor at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, University of California at Santa Cruz, Columbia University in New York City, the University of Pittsburgh, PA, the Roskilde University Center in Denmark, the University of Leipzig in Germany, the Copenhagen Business School in Denmark, the University of Chester and the Birkbeck College, University of London. Among his numerous books, recent titles include the edited special issue of European Planning Studies (EPS) on Industry 4.0 and digitization, September 2021, and a special issue of UCJC Business and Society Review, 2020 (Vol. 17, Num. 1+2) on Divergent Opportunities of Innovation: When Time and Situation matter. He also edited Diversities of Innovation, Routledge 2019 (Paperback 2020); the Handbook on Politics and Technology, Routledge 2016 (Paperback 2018); Europe's Changing Geography, co-edited with N. Bellini Routledge 2013 (Paperback 2017); and Networking Regionalized Innovative Labour Markets, co-edited with H. Lawton Smith, Routledge 2012 (Paperback 2014). He is currently editing Regional and sectoral innovation systems for release in Autumn 2022 (contracted with Routledge) and preparing a book Diversities and Disparities (contracted with Routledge).
